Anita Banbury

Anita is heavily involved in the local choral scene having directed the Orlando Singers for 28 years (including its tour for Chamber Music N Z) and has sung in various Auckland choirs. Anita founded a Combined Choirs Festival and ran it for 20 years. St Mary's Singers, Holy Trinity Cathedral is directed by Anita and is a mixed auditioned choir which sings in the cathedral and elsewhere. She is also a past Chairperson of RSCM, Auckland.

Course Organist - Michael Stoddart

Michael commenced his musical education as a chorister at Westminster Abbey with Christopher Herrick. Later he was appointed Organ Scholar at Magdalen College, Oxford. In London he sang as a deputy lay clerk at St Paul's Cathedral. He then moved to Paris for an extended period of organ study at the Paris Conservatoire with Susan Landale.

As a deputy lay clerk at Portsmouth Cathedral he frequently sang with the choirs of Winchester, Chichester as well as Portsmouth cathedrals

Michael was appointed Organist and Director of Music at Newcastle Cathedral in 2009.

Moving to Auckland in 2016, he maintains a busy schedule of organ playing, choir training, singing and teaching.

Portsmouth born, Peter studied organ, piano and cello at the Royal Academy of Music where he gained prizes for choir training, organ accompaniment and harmony, a raft of diplomas and an honorary Associateship of the Academy. In 1983, Peter became Master of the Music at Derby Cathedral, a post he combined with part-time teaching at Derby's High and Grammar Schools. As Master he also recruited and trained the Cathedral's choirs forming both treble lines from scratch. Peter retired from his post in January 2015 having done 32 years there, with a total of 40 years ministry in English cathedrals.
